Care and Maintenance Guide:

Quartz Collection requires minimal maintenance and is easy to keep clean.

For every day cleaning simply wipe the tops using a soft cloth or sponge with warm water and mild household detergent such as dishwashing liquid and rinse with clean water.

If deeper cleaning is required or necessary use a non-abrasive soft soap such as liquid Chemico and non scratch sponge. Thoroughly rinse with clean water afterwards to remove any residue.

Quartz Collection is virtually non-porous and does not require sealing or polishing to maintain its semi-gloss, smooth finish. When unsure test the cleaning product on a small piece of your counter top that is out of view.

Quartz Collection is an extremely strong material but still you should take care to avoid:

- Sitting, standing or climbing on your work top.
- Direct exposure to hot pots, pans or other hot items, we recommend you use a trivet or wooden board when setting down hot pots or pans.
- Cutting food directly on the surface could lead to dulling of the work surface we recommend using a chopping board to avoid this.
- Knocking, dropping or bumping the product with heavy items.
- Exposure to strong chemicals and solvents. Cleaning with abrasive chemicals can alter the appearance of the surface and cause damage to the work top.
- Avoid using cleaning agents that have high alkaline/pH levels and aggressive cleaning
 agents such as oven cleaners, paint removers and products containing oil, powders,
 xylene, toluene, potassium hydroxide or caustic soda. Do not use paint removers or
 furniture strippers that contain trichlorethane or methylene chloride. Should your surface
 accidentally be exposed to any of these products, rinse immediately with clean water to
 neutralize the effect.
